ACCESS

Access via an entry gate, authorized by institutional registration or visitor code.

Visitor registration and access are granted with a presentation of an official photo ID.

LOCKERS

Unifor's Library provides lockers with keys for students, professors, and employees. These are for the exclusive use of those who use the collection and are restricted to the period of time they remain at the library facilities.

The delay in the return of the keys generates a daily fee. In case of loss, the visitor will have to pay for the replacement of the lock. On the 7th business day of delay, belongings will be removed to the Campus Security and Surveillance Division.

COLLECTION

The collection consists of more than 271 thousand printed and digital works: books, theses, dissertations, technical standards guides, periodicals, TCCs, analog and digital videos, scientific articles, as well as other digital resources found in the various databases made available by the Library, in particular: EMIS (CCG) which contains strategic information on companies, sectors, and countries in over 197 emerging markets, Vlex (CCJ) which contains legal information such as legislation and national case law, Target GedWEB (CCT) offers access to ABNT standards and regulatory documents, Primal Pictures (CCS) provides 3D anatomy atlases, as well as videos and animations in the areas of anatomy, histology and physiology, Dynamed (CCS) provides summaries of clinical evidence to support decisions. HOW TO LOCATE THE DESIRED WORK

In the **Integrated Search**, consult books (printed and digital, periodicals, videos, dissertations, theses, and graduation work). In the **Integrated Journal Search**, access scientific articles from EBSCO Host, CAPES, and vLex portals. Log in to Unifor Online for full access to platform content.

SOPHIA SYSTEM

The Library uses the Sophia system as management software, where you can research the collection (physical and digital). In the user area, you can track your active loans, and renew and reserve books. The system is available for use by the academic community (students, professors, and staff). LATE RETURN

If the book and/or publication is not returned on the scheduled date, the user will pay a fee per working day of delay for each book.
