

MULTIPULM Disclaimer Guide

EU and Swiss Funding Acknowledgements, Logos & Disclaimers

1. Purpose of this guide

This guide explains how MULTIPULM partners should acknowledge project funding in deliverables, communication materials, dissemination outputs, publications, presentations, websites and social media posts.

It covers two funding acknowledgements:

1. European Union funding acknowledgement and disclaimer, based on the MULTIPULM Grant Agreement.
2. Swiss State Secretariat for Education, Research and Innovation (SERI) acknowledgement, based on the SERI manual for recipients of funding.

The MULTIPULM Grant Agreement requires beneficiaries to acknowledge EU support in communication and dissemination activities, including media relations, conferences, seminars, brochures, posters, presentations, electronic materials, traditional media and social media.

The [SERI manual](#) states that SERI-funded partners must mention SERI funding in written publications, reports, scientific publications and public documents, whether print or digital.

2. When should these acknowledgements be used?

Partners should include the relevant acknowledgements in all project-related outputs, including:

- Deliverables and reports
- Scientific publications
- Policy briefs and white papers
- Public documents
- Presentations
- Posters, flyers and brochures
- Website pages and news items
- Press releases
- Social media posts, where space allows
- Videos, podcasts and other audiovisual materials
- Event materials, including agendas and banners

As a simple rule: if the material presents MULTIPULM work, results, activities, partners, events or outputs, the funding acknowledgement should be included.

3. EU disclaimer

The Grant Agreement requires that any communication or dissemination activity related to the action uses factually accurate information and includes the official disclaimer, translated into local languages where appropriate.

Use the following wording:

Funded by the European Union. Views and opinions expressed are however those of the author(s) only and do not necessarily reflect those of the European Union or the European Health and Digital Executive Agency (HADEA). Neither the European Union nor HADEA can be held responsible for them.

For formal deliverables, publications, reports and website pages, use the full disclaimer.

For short social media posts, where space is limited, use the EU emblem/funding statement in the visual when possible and include the full disclaimer on the linked webpage, article, deliverable or publication.

4. Swiss SERI acknowledgement

SERI-funded partners (Mandat International) must acknowledge SERI support in written publications, reports, scientific publications and public documents, including print and digital materials associated with the results of the funded project.

The required reference is provided directly in the [SERI manual](#).

Use the following wording:

This work has received funding from the Swiss State Secretariat for Education, Research and Innovation (SERI).

This acknowledgement should be included whenever the output includes, presents or draws on work involving the Swiss SERI-funded partner.

5. SERI logo use

The SERI logo may be displayed in publications, on websites or in social media in addition to the text acknowledgement. The SERI manual states that logos are available for print and digital use, including .eps, .jpg, .svg and .png formats. It also specifies minimum print sizes: 36.5 mm wide for portrait versions and 66.5 mm wide for landscape versions.

Important rules:

- Use only the official SERI/federal logo provided for funding recipients.
- Do not alter, stretch, recolour or modify the logo.
- Do not use the SERI or federal logo without the addition "Project funded by".
- Download and use the correct logo files from the shared [MULTIPULM logo folder](#):
